

# **WILD WEST PARADE RULES — SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2009 \* 10 a.m.**

## **Please share these rules with all your parade participants!**

1. Parade participants **MAY NOT** throw any kind of candy/souvenirs from a float, vehicle or horseback.
2. Parade participants **MAY** have participants walk along the edge of the street and may **HAND OUT** candy/ souvenirs.
3. Please Do Not Throw Anything into the crowd.
4. Any parade participant that violates this rule **WILL NOT** be eligible for awards!
5. No parade entry is allowed to stop their vehicle during the parade route. If your vehicle begins to overheat please pull out of the parade line as safely as possible.
6. **LATE** arrivals will be placed at the **END** of the parade!! No Exceptions!!
7. No 18 wheelers OR trailers over 30' will be allowed because of tight turns.
8. All Horse & Horse & Trailer entries must have Coggins Test Papers available.
9. All motorized vehicle drivers must be legally licensed.

## **GENERAL RULES & INFORMATION:**

**Cars not participating in the Parade will not be allowed to enter the Staging Area.**  
**Instruct float riders to park behind Brookshire's/McDonalds/Car Wash & walk to their float.**

### **Parade Staging Area:**

- **Cars, Tractors, Walkers & Floats: ONE WAY TRAFFIC ONLY!**

Enter the staging area on Martin Street beside Springtown Flower Shop, turn right at the Shinola's Texas Café and proceed down to your designated Float location displayed by the Float Number Sign.

- **Horses & Wagons: ONE WAY TRAFFIC ONLY!**

Enter staging area by turning at O'Reilly's onto Hilltop Drive then turn right onto Lake Drive by Springtown Farmers Market proceed down to the end of the road for Horse Trailer Parking.

### **Parade Route:**

**The Parade will enter Hwy. 199 from Hilltop Drive proceeding WEST to Hwy. 51, the parade will then turn NORTH on Hwy. 51 to the square and then turn EAST at the City Hall at 2nd Street and proceed to Springtown Elementary for off loading.**

### **General Information:**

1. Parade begins at 10:00 a.m.
2. All entries must be in good taste.
3. Absolutely **NO** political entries will be allowed in the parade.
4. Please submit form prior to September 7, 2009.
5. Parade Numbers will be assigned and issued when entry form is received. (Please keep your parade number for Parade day).
6. Parade Float Number must be clearly displayed to be eligible for awards.
7. Parade Staging will be from 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. (behind **BROOKSHIRE'S**).
8. **NO OFF LOADING** of float riders will be permitted anywhere along the parade route.
9. **Gators, Golf Carts & Shuttles** will be available to shuttle spectators and participants to and from the square and elementary school to pick up kids from their floats.
9. All Floats will off load riders at Springtown Elementary School Campus parking lot. Float Riders are to congregate on the Football Field to wait for pick up.
10. Parade Awards will be announced from the Tabernacle Stage at 12:15 p.m., Please have a representative from your group present at the Awards Presentation.
